## **DETAILS FROM PREVIOUS OWN OR EXTERNAL KNOWLEDGE**

Pearl Harbour attack: Surprise military strike: 2,403 Americans were killed and 1,178 others were wounded. 188 U.S. aircraft were destroyed. Japanese losses were light: 29 aircraft and five midget submarines lost, and 64 servicemen killed.

The surprise attack came as a profound shock to the American people and led directly to the

American entry into World War II in both the Pacific and European theaters.

The following day, December 8, the United States declared war on Japan, and three days later, on December 11, Germany and Italy each declared war on the U.S.

The U.S. responded with a declaration of war against Germany and Italy.

Domestic support for non-interventionism, which had been fading since the Fall of France in 1940, disappeared.

## **DETAILS FROM PREVIOUS OWN OR EXTERNAL KNOWLEDGE**

The **September 11 attacks** (also referred to as **9/11**) were a series of four coordinated terrorist attacks by the Islamic terrorist group al-Qaeda against the United States on the morning of Tuesday, September 11, 2001. The attacks killed 2,996 people, injured over 6,000 others, and caused at least \$10 billion in infrastructure and property damage. Additional people died of 9/11-related cancer and respiratory diseases in the months and years following the attacks.

9/11 is the single deadliest terrorist attack in human history and the single deadliest incident for firefighters and law enforcement officers in the history of the United States, with 343 and 72 killed, respectively.
