EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Public notice for identifying candidates to be invited to participate in the direct award procedure, in accordance with Art.36, comma 2, letter a) of Decree Law No.50/2016 and with ANAC guidelines No.4, updated with the modifications introduced by Decree Law No. 56 of 19th April 2017 with Board Resolution No.206 of 1st March 2018, for a freight tracking service within the Go SMarT Med project, funded under the Interreg Italia Francia Marittimo 2014-2020 Programme, estimated contract value; 17,500.00 Euro net of CIG: ZB422CD4DD CUP F66D17000040006

The Dipartimento di Scienze Economiche e Aziendali-CIREM of the University of Cagliari, upon request of Prof. Paolo Fadda to procure a freight tracking service, within the Go SMarT Med project, funded under the 1st call of the Interreg Italia Francia Marittimo 2014-2020 Programme, for identifying candidates to be invited to participate in the procedure, initiated in accordance with Art..36, comma 2, letter a) of Decree Law No.50/2016 and with ANAC guidelines No.4, updated with the modifications introduced by Decree Law No. 56 of 19th April 2017 with Board Resolution No.206 of 1st March 2018, for the direct award of a freight tracking service , is issuing this request for expressions of interest from economic operators on the market in possession of the requirements.

ART. 1 SUBJECT OF THE CONTRACT

The service consists of:

1. A state-of-the-art survey of the main freight tracking principles applicable to containerised and full truckload freight shipped by sea.
2. Testing the tracking technology in possession of the candidate along at least two of the Mediterranean shipping routes under study in the Go SMarT Med project.

The proposed tracking technology shall be tested (indicatively) on 30 semi-trailers/ container units shipped along two Mediterranean routes to be identified by the contracting authority. The two routes shall include at least one transshipment.

The tracking system employed for testing shall satisfy the following requirements:

- easy installation;
- simple and intuitive interfaces for consulting information;
- enable the user to track the shipment of the container/semi-trailer along the entire journey, both by sea and overland, and monitor stops and movements.
- enable the user to locate the position of container/semi-trailer in real time, using a smartphone or PC;
- enable the user to retrieve and store information about the movements of the shipment, for analysis and subsequent checks;
- system for controlling and monitoring temperature and humidity conditions;
- anti-tamper and alarm device;



- triaxial accelerometer.

3. Drafting a final technical report on the results of the tests conducted complete with technical- economic feasibility analysis.

The completion date for all the above described activities is fixed as no later than June 5th 2018 with submission of the following final documents::

1. state-of-the-art report on freight tracking systems;
2. detailed technical report on the results of tests conducted at sea;
3. technical-economic assessment of the feasibility of applying the technology at a broader scale within the optimised Go SMarT Med transportation network.

Additionally, two coordination meetings are envisaged (at least one face-to-face with the technical staff of CIREM (Dipartimento di Scienze Economiche e Aziendali – UNICA);

All the data produced shall be delivered to the Dipartimento di Scienze Economiche ed Aziendali and shall remain at all times the sole and exclusive property of the Go SMarT Med project.

ART. 2 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS

To participate in the procedure, candidates must meet the following requirements:

- 1) non-existence of grounds for exclusion from public procurement procedures in compliance with Art. 80 of the Italian Public Procurement Code, referred specifically to the Company and all those subjects indicated in the Code;
- 2) For Italian companies, registration with the responsible Chamber of Commerce, Industry, Craft Trades and Agriculture (C.C.I.A.A.) in accordance with Art. 83, comma 3, of the Code,
- 3) Companies not registered in Italy must be registered in the country of residence in compliance with that country's regulations.

This public notice will remain on the University of Cagliari's website for a period of 15 days as from the day after its publication. Economic operators interested in participating in the procedure should send their expression of interest, completing the attached form (A) no later than 2/04/2018 to the following e-mail: protocollo@pec.unica.it

ART. 3 VERIFICATION OF SUITABILITY AND SUBSEQUENT STEPS

The economic operators to be invited to participate in the direct award procedure will be identified amongst those who have regularly expressed their interest.

The Dipartimento di Scienze Economiche ed Aziendali reserves the right to proceed with said procedure even if the number of expressions of interest received is less than 5 (five) if necessary also increasing the number of economic operators to be invited retrieving them from additional lists prepared by the contracting authority on the basis of indications provided by the responsible scientist of the project and without prejudice to the right to proceed in any case with the procedure even if only 1 (one) expression of interest has been received.



All the economic operators invited to participate in the procedure, must possess the requirements set out in Art. 2 of the present notice. Failure to comply will result in exclusion.

In order to correctly determine the value of the contract, the services offered for the activities set out in Art. 1 of the present notice will be evaluated as well as the cost of each service. Particularly, with regard to the service for testing the tracking technology described under Art. 1, item 1, of the present notice, should the different technologies proposed perform equally well, preference will be given to those solutions whose large scale application over the long term results in a lower cost to the end user

ART. 4 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The eligible candidates will be invited to submit an offer in accordance with the terms and conditions indicated in the letter of invitation.

The present public notice is intended merely as a preselection process to solicit expressions of interest. Said notice shall not bind the contracting authority which reserves the right to suspend, revoke, or in any case not proceed with the procedure described herein or even to change the implementation conditions or replace them with other procurement procedures. In this case the economic operators shall not be entitled to claim expectation damages or any form of compensation.

Economic operators wishing to express their interest are invited to fill in the attached form (A). The contracting authority will send all communications and administrative documents for the subsequent procedure (if necessary) by e-mail from the address indicated in the attached form.

In case of conflict the Italian version of the document will prevail and will therefore be the binding version

The data collected will be processed solely for the purposes of the present public notice in accordance with Decree Law No. 196/03.
